

District Response Plan In the Event of +Positive COVID Test

In the event a person at the facility/worksites tests +Positive for COVID-19, the following steps will be implemented. Depending on the facility, additional steps may also be required. These procedures are in compliance with guidance and direction provided by the Santa Clara County Health Department (SCCHD).

1. Immediately remove the infected person from the facility/worksites and ensure they are no longer occupying the same space as any other persons.
2. Instruct the infected person to stay home and isolate in accordance with SCCHD instructions listed at www.sccsafeworkplace.org.
3. Notify the SCCHD within four (4) hours of learning of the positive case by following the instructions at www.sccsafeworkplace.org.
4. Identify any coworkers (and any other persons, if known) who had close contact with the infected person.
5. Comply immediately with any case investigation, contact tracing, and worksite investigation measures by the SCCHD. This will include providing names, addresses, phone numbers, and work dates and times for close contacts of the infected person, which employers are required by law to provide the SCCHD upon request.
6. Exclude all Close Contacts from the facility/worksites or any other jobsite in accordance with SCCHD instructions listed at www.sccsafeworkplace.org.
7. Implement cleaning and disinfection measures for areas recently visited by the infected person as set forth in www.sccsafeworkplace.org, and close off areas visited by the infected person until cleaning and disinfection is complete.
